## FUTUREBOUND

Take a journey into the unknown with Futurebound, a range of decorative weaves that combines a feeling of Hi Tech luxe with space-age forms.

Futurebound mixes a futuristic, luxury aesthetic with punk themed industrial references and neoclassical designs to create nine enticing textiles. An avant-garde collection, Futurebound sees for the first time Kirkby Design develop a range of drapery qualities, which sit effortlessly alongside classic upholstery fabrics.

Futurebound is an ultramodern collection where abstract forms reminiscent of planetary surfaces adorn supple weaves, while a lustrous tartan and fluid camouflage appear on rich velvet. Glimmering metallics have the appearance of liquid metal, while a reformed damask and traditional houndstooth are modern reworks of classical references. Coloured in a fashionable palette of muted pastels with vibrant flashes of sapphire blue and warm peridot, Futurebound is a contemporary collection that demands attention.

**PLASMA  
EMBOSSSED FR VELVET**

Soft, curved lines give the impression of molten plasma poured onto tactile, fire retardant velvet, embossed using a traditional bronze cylinder that was hand carved by an artisan at the end of the 19<sup>th</sup> century.

**QUASAR  
DECORATIVE VELVET**

Inspired by the punk rock scene of the 1970s, a soft velvet reveals a traditional tartan pattern with a timeworn appearance and subtle lustrous quality. Created through an innovative process, where electric needles punch the pile to create the tartan design on the ground cloth before being dyed.

### **PENDULUM WIDE WIDTH PRINTED LINEN**

Two worlds collide as natural linen appears to have been dipped in liquid metal; the shine of the metallic tones contrasts with the dryness of the relaxed, linen quality.

### **PARRALLAX METALLIC WEAVE**

A fluid weave with a unique, real metallic yarn of either copper or silver, allows the fabric to be moulded and shaped into different forms as you desire. With a futuristic feel and technological look, Parrallax is reminiscent of liquid metal with its electric sheen.

**FR JACQUARD WEAVE**

Fluid in design and handle, Nebula is reminiscent of the hazy, abstract appearance of planetary surfaces, with a lustrous quality and contemporary feel.

### **CONSTELLATION CRUSHED VELVET**

An opulent crushed velvet with a luxurious texture, Constellation is rich with drama. The velvet has been cross dyed, a technique where the fabric is dyed twice with each fibre absorbing a different type of dye to achieve a two-colour effect.

### **OPTIMUS JACQUARD WEAVE**

A modern hint to a classic design, matt and shiny yarns combine to create a pixelated damask design with a contemporary, digital edge. A tumbled finish gives the cloth a soft handle for drapery, as well as a relaxed, casual feel, and an almost three-dimensional appearance to the design.

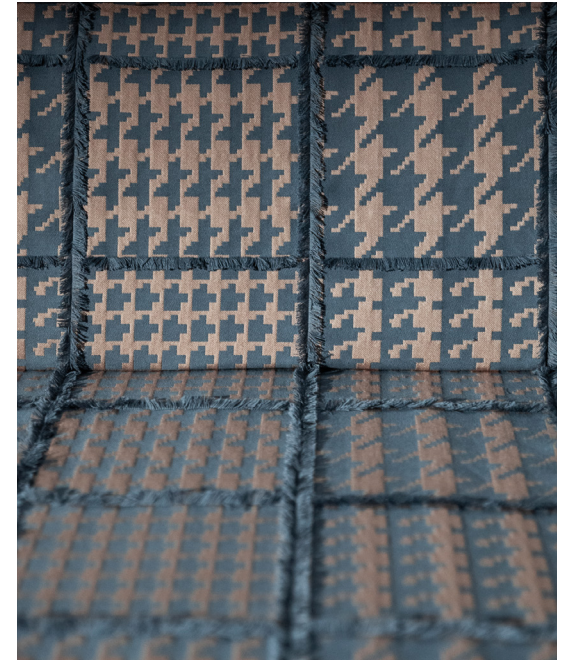




### **BINARY JACQUARD WEAVE**
